RE: CC Docket 02-33 - Notice of Permissive Detariffing of
Wireline Broadband Internet Access Transmission Service

Dear Secretary Dortch:

On behalf of Sherwood Mutual Telephone Association, Inc., Sherwood, Ohio ("Sherwood") and consistent with the requirements of paragraph 101 of the Commission's Report and Order in CC Docket Number 02-33, released September 23, 2005 (the "*Wireline Broadband Order*"), this is to notify the Commission that Sherwood intends to discontinue offering its wireline broadband Internet access transmission service ("DSL Service") on a tariffed basis. Although its DSL Service will be detariffed, Sherwood will continue to offer it on a common carrier basis. Accordingly, the following area will be removed from the list of carriers providing DSL service under Broadband Network Group, LLC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, effective July 1, 2009:

Sherwood is currently offering its DSL Service to one customer. Notification to that customer occurred contemporaneous with the filing of this correspondence by personal delivery. A copy of that notice is attached hereto. Further, a copy of this Notice of Permissive Detariffing has been served upon the Governor of Ohio, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, the Special Assistant for Telecommunications at the Department of Defense, and to Broadband Network Group, LLC.

Notice by Sherwood Mutual Telephone Association, Inc. to Provide Wireline Broadband
Internet Access Transmission Service on a Detariffed Basis
May 27, 2009

Pursuant to the Report and Order released September 23, 2005 by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), facilities-based wireline carriers are permitted to offer broadband Internet access transmission common carrier services either pursuant to tariff or on a de-tariffed basis. Effective July 1, 2009, Sherwood Mutual Telephone Association, Inc. ("Sherwood") will begin offering its broadband Internet access transmission service (the "DSL Service") on a detariffed basis. The terms and conditions of the DSL Service are available for review at Sherwood's business address of P. O. Box 4572, Sherwood, Ohio 43556 and will be available on its website at www.smta.cc by July 1, 2009.


The reason Sherwood has decided to offer its DSL Service on a detariffed basis is simple. Currently, Sherwood is required to offer its DSL Service pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions of the Broadband Network Group, LLC ("BNG") Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. The BNG tariffed rates are average rates that are higher than the rates Sherwood can offer on a detariffed basis. As a result of Sherwood detariffing the DSL Service, we hope to increase the use of broadband Internet access, a goal shared not only by Sherwood but also by the Federal government and the State of Ohio.

Although the detariffing of the DSL Service does not constitute a discontinuance of the service, the FCC requires carriers that make this change to follow procedures similar to those required for discontinuance. Consistent with those requirements, please be advised that the address for Sherwood is P. O. Box 4572, Sherwood, Ohio 43556 and that the geographic area affected by this change is Sherwood, Ohio.

The FCC will normally authorize this detariffing of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. Address your comments to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the §63.71 Application of Sherwood Mutual Telephone Association, Inc. Comments should include specific information about the impact on you or your company of Sherwood's plans to provide its DSL Service on a detariffed basis.


